Establishment of “Pro-hygiene” product line

Online IT and CE (Consumer Electronics) goods vendor – Harris Technology Group Limited (ASX:HT8) has established a new line of protective hygiene products to be known as “Pro-Hygiene”. The Pro-Hygiene range will include a range of facemasks, hand sanitiser gels and alcohol wipes. Sales will be made through HT8’s own e-commerce website and other distribution partners.

HT8 has been authorised by China’s Jointown Pharmaceutical Group (one of the leading medical supply and distribution companies in China) to distribute its Jointown and Aumacom face masks. HT8 has sold an initial 30,000 face masks in March. A new shipment of 200,000 TGA approved face masks have arrived in Australia and will be available for sale in late April.

HT8 has been appointed by China based COTDYA Fine Chemicals Co. Ltd to market its GOTDYA branded hand sanitiser products in Australia. The first shipment of 90,000 units is in transit and is expected to be available for sale in early May. Orders have been placed for a further 225,000 units of hand sanitisers.

HT8 expects total revenue from sales of the Pro-Hygiene products to reach \$400,000 for the quarter ending 30 June 2020.

HT8 Managing Director Garrison Huang said:

“Our move into the PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) takes advantage of our years of experience in product sourcing and relationship building. The establishment of the Pro-Hygiene range is a long-term strategy as we expect that spending by consumers on PPE products will be far greater in 2020 and onwards than it has been in the past.”

The release of this announcement was authorised by the Company’s Chairman on behalf of the HT8 Board.
