

# Australian Class Actions – Settlement Approval Confirmation

### Summary

• The Federal Court of Australia has today made orders approving the settlements for each of the Williamtown, Katherine and Oakey contamination class actions against the Commonwealth of Australia.

Omni Bridgeway Limited (**Omni Bridgeway**) refers to its announcement of 9 June 2020 (**Preliminary Approval Announcement**) and confirms that Justice Lee of the Federal Court of Australia has made orders today approving the settlements of the Williamtown, Katherine and Oakey contamination class actions against the Commonwealth of Australia.

The details provided in the Preliminary Approval Announcement are consistent with today's orders. The settlements are now unconditional, subject to any appeals.
