Results of 2020 Annual Meeting

WELLINGTON, 13 August 2020 - Xero Limited (ASX: XRO) held its 2020 Annual Meeting today at 11.00am NZT (9.00am AEST).

The following ordinary resolutions were put to shareholders of Xero at the Annual Meeting and passed by way of poll:

- 1. That the Board is authorised to fix the remuneration of the auditor for the ensuing year.
- 2. That Lee Hatton, retiring from office as a director of Xero at the meeting, and being eligible, be re-elected as a director of Xero.
- 3. That Rod Drury, retiring from office as a director of Xero at the Meeting, and being eligible, be re-elected as a director of Xero.
- 4. That Mark Cross, appointed by the Board as a director of Xero on 1 April 2020, and who will retire at the meeting in accordance with clause 20.4 of Xero's constitution, and being eligible, be elected as a director of Xero.
