AJ Park cleared to acquire Baldwins Intellectual Property

IPH Limited (IPH) welcomes the announcement by the New Zealand Commerce Commission today that it will grant clearance for the proposed acquisition by IPH's subsidiary, AJ Park, of the business of New Zealand intellectual property firm, Baldwins Intellectual Property (Baldwins).

AJ Park reached an agreement to acquire Baldwins on 10 June 2020. The transaction is expected to complete in mid-October 2020.
