Conversion of Listed Options to Fully Paid Ordinary Shares

Indiana Resources Limited (ASX: IDA) ('Indiana' or 'the Company') wishes to advise that is has received valid applications and has today actioned exercise of a total of 4,017,061 Listed Options (ASX: IDAOA) exercisable at \$0.03 and expiring on 5 August 2021, into Fully Paid Ordinary Shares. The conversion of Listed Options has provided the Company with additional funding of \$120,511.83.

Company Comment

Indiana's Executive Chairman Bronwyn Barnes said: "I am pleased to see shareholders commencing to exercise their options and convert to shares. With drilling planned for November in South Australia, we are keen to use the existing funds to support exploration activity across our land package in the Gawler Craton. There are no plans to undertake a placement as the Board remains focused on minimising dilution to shareholders at a time when we can see a real opportunity for value creation through exploration activity. If all options are exercised prior to their expiry date of 5th August 2021, the Company will receive more than \$4.9 million in funds. This will allow us to commence with our current planned exploration activity and have sufficient funds to follow up results as they are delivered."

The Company has also resolved to issue 3,500,000 unlisted Options exercisable at \$0.06 on or before 1 December 2023, to Delta Resources Management Pty Ltd (or its nominee) pursuant to the corporate and technical services provided to the Company and relating to GIS, mapping, computing and support personnel services, management of the database of information, including historical data relating to the assets of the Company.

- There are no participating rights or entitlements inherent in the options and option holders will not be entitled to participate in new issues of capital offered to Shareholders during the currency of the options.
