

Viva Leisure introduces new bi-monthly trading update format and provides outlook for FY21.

Viva Leisure Limited (**Viva Leisure**) (ASX:VVA) wishes to update the market on its trading status and introduce its new bi-monthly reporting format.

Bi-Monthly Reporting Presentation

Viva Leisure is pleased to present its first bi-monthly trading update presentation which has been designed to provide shareholders with key relevant data in relation to the different segments that the business operates.

The bi-monthly report includes unaudited management results until April 2021, with the next report scheduled for release in July 2021 to include performance metrics and commentary for the May and June 2020 period.

FY21 Full Year Outlook

Viva Leisure wishes to update the market on its projected FY21 full year result.

Key Metrics include:

- Revenue range \$81 million to \$83 million
- Trading EBITDA range \$13.0 million to \$13.5 million (pre-AASB16)
 Excludes any one-off adjustments
- EBITDA margin 16.5% to 17.5%

The outlook represents the following increases over H1-FY21

- Revenue increase of 25.6% to 31.2%
- EBITDA increase of 32.1% to 41.1%
- Margin increase from 15.5% to a range of 16.5% to 17.5%

The full year FY21 result will be impacted by increased costs as roll-outs were accelerated and were slower to break-even due to COVID, legal fees on acquisitions completed and opportunities currently under review, costs related to capital raises, and debt facility restructure fees.
