# Viva Leisure welcomes opening of Victorian locations

- 82% of Viva Leisure locations now open
- Part of the NSW portfolio (18% or 21 locations) remains closed due to Government restrictions
- Majority of NSW team currently on stand-down pending re-opening

#### 82% of locations Open for business

Viva Leisure Limited (**Viva Leisure**) (ASX:VVA) wishes to update the market on the status of its facilities across all markets.

As advised in our 22 July 2021 market announcement, Viva Leisure had 38 corporate owned locations closed (32% of the portfolio) in Victoria and New South Wales. With the announcement by the Victorian Government on the easing of restrictions from today, Viva Leisure's 17 Victorian locations have now opened. With 21 of our NSW locations remaining closed (18% of locations), this results in 82% of Viva Leisure locations open and operating.

Viva Leisure's CEO and Managing Director, Harry Konstantinou said:

"The easing of restrictions in Victoria highlight the importance of gyms on physical and mental health and wellbeing. It is encouraging to have 82% of our locations back operating, including our thousands of members in Victoria being able to return to exercising in a safe, controlled and managed environment."
