Re: ASX Appendix 3G in relation to Challenger Performance Rights

Attached is an ASX Appendix 3G relating to 17,628,817 unlisted performance rights (**Performance Rights**) which have been previously issued by Challenger Limited (**Challenger**) and, which on satisfaction of the relevant vesting conditions entitle the holder to one ordinary share in Challenger (**Share**). This filing relates to the historical Performance Rights position for Challenger as at 30 June 2021.

As discussed with Challenger's ASX listing officer, it has been recently discovered that Challenger has not historically lodged relevant forms with the ASX when it has issued various Performance Rights to its employees under its employee incentive scheme. It is advised that in respect of all historical issuances of Performance Rights that vested on or prior to 30 June 2021 those Performance Rights were satisfied by the transfer to the relevant employee of Challenger Shares which were held by the Challenger employee share scheme trust and which were acquired by the trustee of that trust on-market.

Following the lodgement of the Appendix 3G attached to this document, Challenger will be lodging various forms with the ASX that relate to changes in Performance Rights which have occurred on or from 1 July 2021 so that the market is fully informed of the number of Shares and Performance Rights which Challenger currently has on issue. Challenger has also updated its internal processes to ensure that the appropriate forms will be lodged with ASX in respect of both quoted and unquoted securities at all relevant times going forward.
