JLG extends contract with Suncorp for building insurance repairs

Johns Lyng Group (ASX:JLG) has successfully extended its contract with one of Australia's largest insurers, the Suncorp Group, for the provision of domestic building insurance repairs across New South Wales, Victoria, Queensland, South Australia, the Australian Capital Territory and the Northern Territory.

This extension took effect from November 1, 2021, and is for an initial three year term with a further one year option.

Johns Lyng Chief Executive, Scott Didier AM said that this extension reflects an important evolution of the relationship between JLG and its key partner, Suncorp.

"Since being initially appointed to Suncorp's Victoria panel three years ago, JLG was subsequently appointed to panels in New South Wales, Queensland, South Australia, the ACT and NT," Mr Didier said.

"The extension of this arrangement is testament to not only the strength of our relationship with Suncorp but also our ability to provide consistent, market-leading services within the industry; something we're incredibly proud of.

"We're pleased to be able to continue offering Suncorp a truly national service that meets the needs of their customers, wherever they are, particularly with unpredictable weather events predicted to increase."
