# Phase 1 Maryland Express Lanes project update

As part of the recent FY22 Results Presentation, Transurban provided an update on the Maryland Express Lanes Project<sup>1</sup>. Further to that update:

- Accelerate Maryland Partners (AM Partners)<sup>2</sup> has selected a Tutor Perini led team, as design and construction (D&C) contractors for Phase 1 South of the New American Legion Bridge I-270 Traffic Relief Plan (referred to as the Maryland Express Lanes Project). The project is expected to deliver critical congestion relief by extending Express Lanes into Maryland and replacing and expanding the American Legion Bridge connecting Maryland and Virginia
- AM Partners will work with the Tutor Perini team to drive value and efficiencies in the project's design, pricing, and delivery, through the early development, in order to submit a Committed Section Proposal and execute a D&C Contract
- The final step of the environmental review process for Phase 1 South of the project (National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Record of Decision) was successfully reached on 25 August 2022
