CHANGES TO SCENTRE GROUP BOARD

Scentre Group (ASX: SCG / ASX: CDP) today announced the appointment of Steve McCann to the Board, effective 1 November 2022.

Prior to joining Lendlease, he had 15 years' experience in property, funds management, investment banking and capital markets transactions gained through senior leadership roles at ABN AMRO and Bankers Trust. Steve was previously a mergers and acquisitions lawyer at Freehills, now HSF.
