July 2021 Successful A\$50M fund raising to advance NAL acquisition; A\$20M SPP strongly backed by shareholders	October 2021 US\$86.5M acquisition of 60% stake in Moblan, funded by A\$100M placement	March 2022 Québec lithium resource base doubles to approx. 120 Mt	
August 2021 Completion of NAL acquisition for C\$94M	January 2022 Northern hub expanded with new Lac Albert claims	April 2022 NOVONIX battery tests confirm quality of Authier product	May 2022 PFS confirms NAL's viability, with NPV of A\$1B (8% discount) successful A\$190M placement



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Stepping Up Lithium Value Chain



- Complete NAL restart plan & Abitibi hub
- Develop Moblan as northern hub and commence feasibility studies

2023 - 2024

- Targeting Abitibi hub production up to 220kt of SC6
- Develop Abitibi downstream refinery plans
- Expand northern hub resource base



2025 - 2026

- Targeting start of refinery operations at Abitibi
- Ramp-up SC6 production at Moblan to full capacity
- Develop refinery operation to support lithium production from northern hub

NAL Restart On Track Q1 23

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
ASX:SYA

- 98% procurement completed; 96% of permits obtained
- No lost time incidents reported
- PFS launched to evaluate lithium carbonate production results due Q1 2023
- Québec rail contract signed for delivery to port
- Mining contractor appointed, operations underway
- Senior management appointed, including Interim General Manager, Exploration Director, Finance Director, Vice President Health and Safety

Jourdan acquisition

Potential swift increase to NAL resource, production

- Jourdan's Vallée Lithium Project comprises 48 claims spanning 1,997 ha, adjacent to NAL (19 claims covering 582 ha)
- Opportunity to swiftly expand NAL resource base and future mine production capacity
- NAL acquiring 20 claims outright, with right to earn up to 51% stake in remaining 28 claims
- 9.99% shareholding to be acquired in Jourdan
- Vallée spodumene to be fast tracked through NAL plant

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Northern Hub Developing

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- Moblan drilling program continuing 33,348m drilled as of end October, 640m remaining for completion in November
- Discovery of significant new southern lithium pegmatite zone; drilling results expected by year-end
- Acquired 121 new claims adjacent to Moblan (Lac Albert)
 - Advances Québec Govt's strategy for lithium hub in James Bay region (IQ's SOQUEM holds 40% stake in Moblan)

Moblan PFS underway, expected by May 2023 followed by DFS due September 23
