PEXA IN-SPECIE DISTRIBUTION: DRAFT ATO CLASS RULING

Link Administration Holdings Limited (ASX: LNK) (**Link Group**) refers to proposed in-specie distribution of Link Group's shareholding in PEXA Group Limited pursuant to a capital reduction, which may be accompanied by a dividend (**Distribution**) as detailed in the explanatory statement and notice of meeting released by Link Group to the ASX on 22 November 2022 (**Explanatory Memorandum**).

As outlined in the Explanatory Memorandum, a class ruling was sought from the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) to confirm the key taxation implications of the Distribution. The ATO has now provided Link Group with a draft class ruling. The draft class ruling is not binding on the ATO and only the final class ruling can be relied on by Link Group shareholders. When the final class ruling is issued by the ATO, it will be available on Link Group's website at www.linkgroup.com and the ATO's website at www.ato.gov.au.

The Extraordinary General Meeting for Link Group shareholders to vote on the Distribution will be held through an online platform at https://meetings.linkgroup.com/LNKEG22 at 10.00am (Sydney time) on 23 December 2022.
