New Board Appointment

Alligator Energy Limited **ASX: AGE** (**Alligator** or the **Company**) is pleased to advise the appointment of Ms Fiona Nicholls to the Board of Directors. Fiona will replace Andrew Vigar, a founding director, who has tendered his resignation to focus on his current executive commitments.

Fiona brings 30 years of experience in the global resources industry to the Alligator Board having worked across a range of business functions including strategy and planning, exploration and operations, multi-country project development and approvals, due diligence and assurance processes, crisis management and organisational change.

Importantly, as Alligator pursues the near-term opportunity of developing the Samphire Project, Fiona beings a wealth of experience in successfully implementing the principles of sustainable development particularly in the areas of implementing practical solutions that are innovative, effective and scalable.

In her latest executive role as the VP External Relations for Rio Tinto Energy, Fiona was responsible for the policy development and strategic positioning of the Energy Product Group which included its uranium businesses with respect to sustainable development, product stewardship, climate change, community and Aboriginal relations, media, communications, and government relations. Fiona was also a previous director of Rössing Uranium Ltd, and a stand-in director for Energy Resources of Australia Ltd, and hence has a comprehensive understanding of the management priorities around such projects.
