Update on fibre seed growing operations

Ecofibre Limited (Ecofibre, Company) (ASX:EOF) provides an update on its fibre seed growing operations.

In late 1H23, Ecofibre exported 132 tonnes of hemp fibre planting seed from Australia to customers in the United States.

At the time of dispatch, seed germination rates were tested and exceeded 85%, the industry benchmark. However, subsequent crop germination rates have been low, and it appears that the seed was damaged in transit despite the use of refrigerated containers.

This issue has not previously occurred with Ecofibre's seed exports and is now under investigation with the transport company and Ecofibre's marine transit insurers.

The net financial impact of the seed damage in FY23 and FY24 will be in the order of \$1-2m AUD:

- FY23: sales previously invoiced to affected growers will be credited as at 30 June 2023
- FY24: monies paid by growers will either be refunded or held pending the supply of replacement seed. Grower and insurance claims will also be resolved.

Ecofibre will provide a further update to the market once the Company's insurance claim has been finalised.
