- (i) RCOP (on a before and after tax basis) is a non-International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) measure commonly used within the global downstream oil industry. It is unaudited and derived from the statutory profit adjusted for inventory (losses)/gains. RCOP excludes the unintended impact of the fall or rise in oil and product prices (key external factors). It is calculated by restating the cost of sales using the replacement cost of goods sold rather than the statutory costs and adjusting for the effect of contract-based revenue lags. Refer to note B3 in the Financial Statements for a reconciliation of Statutory Profit to Replacement Cost basis profit.
- (ii) There is no conduit foreign income component distributed in relation to the dividend. There is no Dividend Reinvestment Plan in operation.
- (iii) Net tangible asset backing per share is derived by dividing net tangible assets by the number of shares issued. Net tangible assets are net assets attributable to members of Ampol less intangible assets. The number of ordinary shares used in the calculation of net tangible assets per share was 238 million (2022: 238 million).
- (iv) Significant Items are events that Management and the Board consider to be outside the scope of usual business. These are excluded to give a clearer reflection of underlying financial performance from one period to the next.
