Incident at the Mana Mine in Burkina Faso

Perenti advises that on 27 February, an incident occurred at the Mana mine in Burkina Faso which has resulted in the tragic fatality of an African Underground Mining Services ("AUMS") employee. AUMS underground mining operations at Mana have been temporarily suspended. The incident will not have a material impact on FY24 guidance.

AUMS is a 100% owned subsidiary of Perenti and is an underground mining contractor for Endeavour Mining at their Mana mine.

AUMS is focused on providing direct and ongoing support to the family of our colleague and workmates in Burkina Faso.

Perenti expresses its heartfelt sympathies to the family, friends and workmates of our colleague involved in the incident. This loss will be profoundly felt across the local communities in Burkina Faso and our workforce more broadly. We will work closely with Endeavour Mining and Burkinabe authorities to thoroughly investigate this incident and address the findings.
