Request for Voluntary Suspension

ABx Group Limited (ASX: **ABX**) (the **Company**) requests an immediate suspension to the trading of the Company's securities (ASX: **ABX** and **ABXO**) quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (**ASX**) in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2.

The voluntary suspension is requested pending an announcement by the Company to the market in relation to a capital raising (**stated purpose**) as referred to in the Trading Halt request dated 16 December 2024.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2, the Company provides the following information in relation to the request:

- 1. The voluntary suspension is necessary to assist the Company in managing its continuous disclosure obligations as the Company expects to make an announcement to the market in relation to the stated purpose above.
- 2. The Company requests that the voluntary suspension remains in place until the earlier of commencement of normal trading on Friday, 20 December 2024, or when the announcement regarding the stated purpose is released to the market.
- 3. The Company expects to make the announcement to the market before the commencement of normal trading on Friday, 20 December 2024.
- 4. The Company is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted or of any further information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
