Paladin Shares to Commence Trading on the TSX

Paladin Energy Ltd (ASX:PDN OTCQX:PALAF) ("Paladin") is pleased to announce that its shares will commence trading on the Toronto Stock Exchange ("TSX") at 9:30 am Toronto time on 27 December 2024 under the ticker symbol "PDN". Paladin has retained its primary listing on the ASX under the ticker symbol "PDN".

Paladin's TSX listing follows the completion of its acquisition of all of the issued and outstanding common shares (the "Fission Shares") of Fission Uranium Corp. ("Fission") on 23 December 2024 by way of a court-approved plan of arrangement under the Canada Business Corporations Act ("Arrangement"). The Fission Shares were delisted from the TSX at market close on 24 December 2024.
