FMG Pilbara Pty Ltd's off-market takeover bid for all the shares of Red Hawk Mining Limited – Notice of Compulsory Acquisition

We act for FMG Pilbara Pty Ltd ACN 106 943 828 (**FMG Pilbara**) (a wholly-owned subsidiary of Fortescue Limited ACN 002 594 872 (ASX: FMG)) in relation to its off-market takeover bid under Chapter 6 of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) (**Corporations Act**) for all of the fully paid ordinary shares in the capital of Red Hawk Mining Limited ACN 091 118 044 (ASX: RHK) (**Red Hawk**) (**Offer**) on the terms set out in its bidder's statement dated 28 January 2025 (**Bidder's Statement**).

Dear Red Hawk Shareholder,

FMG Pilbara Pty Ltd's off-market takeover bid for all the shares of Red Hawk Mining Limited – Notice of Compulsory Acquisition

We refer to the off-market takeover bid by FMG Pilbara Pty Ltd ACN 106 943 828 (**FMG Pilbara**), a wholly owned subsidiary of Fortescue Ltd ACN 002 594 872 (ASX: FMG), under Chapter 6 of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) (**Corporations Act**) to acquire all of the ordinary shares in Red Hawk Mining Limited ACN 091 118 044 (ASX: RHK) (**Red Hawk**) (the **Offer**).

As you may be aware, as at 18 February 2025, FMG Pilbara has acquired a relevant interest in more than 90% of the ordinary shares in Red Hawk (**Red Hawk Shares**), and has acquired more than 75% of the Red Hawk Shares that it offered to acquire under the Offer.

Accordingly, FMG Pilbara will now exercise its right to compulsorily acquire the remaining Red Hawk Shares in which FMG Pilbara does not have a relevant interest under the compulsory acquisition provisions of the Corporations Act.

Red Hawk shareholders who have not accepted the Offer may still do so by the scheduled Offer closing time of 7:00pm (AEDT) on Monday, 3 March 2025, unless extended or withdrawn. Red Hawk shareholders who accept the Offer by this closing date will receive the consideration for their Red Hawk Shares earlier, instead of having to wait to be acquired under the compulsory acquisition process.

FMG Pilbara will acquire any Red Hawk Shares remaining after the close of the Offer, under the compulsory acquisition provisions of the Corporations Act. The compulsory acquisition will be on the same terms as the Offer (i.e. the consideration of A\$1.20 per Red Hawk Share).

If you do not accept the Offer before the scheduled closing time for the Offer, on completion of the compulsory acquisition procedure, FMG Pilbara will pay to Red Hawk the consideration for the Red Hawk Shares that it compulsorily acquires. You will then be entitled to claim the consideration from Red Hawk.

Red Hawk will give notice to shareholders once it has received the consideration and advise how you may claim the consideration. Subject to the Corporations Act, this is expected to occur five to six weeks after the date of this letter.

See also the enclosed copy of ASIC Form 6021 *Notice of Compulsory Acquisition Following Takeover Bid* (**Compulsory Acquisition Notice**), which sets out the compulsory acquisition process and your rights.

Under ASX Listing Rule 17.4, ASX will suspend quotation of Red Hawk Shares five business days after the date of the Compulsory Acquisition Notice. Once suspended, ASX will remove Red Hawk from the official list of the ASX at the close of trading on a date to be determined.
