Acusensus awarded new contract for NSW mobile phone and seatbelt detection program

Highlights

- Following a tender process, Acusensus has executed a new framework contract with Transport for NSW for the mobile phone and seatbelt detection program, replacing the existing world first program which commenced when Acusensus started supplying Transport for NSW with mobile phone detection camera services in 2019
- The framework agreement has a five-year initial term, with two options to renew, each for a 12-month period (**Framework Agreement**), marking a step change compared to the base period of a two-year initial term in the original agreement signed in 2019
- Initial project orders executed under the Framework Agreement have a value of \$8.94m (excluding GST) per annum. These project orders commenced on 1 March 2025 and have an initial term of two years, with a first option to renew for a two-year period and a second option to renew for a further one-year period

Acusensus Limited (ASX:ACE) (**Acusensus** or the **Company**), a technology company designing and developing artificial intelligence enabled road safety solutions, is proud to announce that Acusensus Australia Pty Ltd, a wholly owned subsidiary of Acusensus, has recontracted with Transport for NSW for the delivery of its mobile phone and seatbelt detection services under a new Framework Agreement and has signed associated project orders for delivery of mobile phone and seatbelt detection services.

Acusensus Australia Pty Ltd enters into the Framework Agreement after being the successful party in a tender for these services. The Framework Agreement stands in place of the original agreement that Acusensus signed for the world-first mobile detection program, which commenced in 2019. The Framework Agreement has an initial term of five years from its commencement date, with two further options to renew, each for a 12-month period.

Initial project orders under which services will be delivered have been executed under the Framework Agreement. These orders commenced on 1 March 2025 and replace all existing project orders in operation under the previous agreement. These initial orders have a term of two years, with a first option to renew for a two-year period and a second option to renew for a further one-year period. The annual value of the services to be provided under the project orders is \$8.94m (excluding GST).

Acusensus Founder and Managing Director, Alexander Jannink, said:

“The contract with Transport for NSW was Acusensus’ first long-term contract following its incorporation and I am proud that we will be able to continue our partnership with the NSW Government. It has been incredibly fulfilling to witness state-wide behavioural changes as a result of the introduction of the original program and Acusensus remains fully committed to furthering this progress to reduce road fatalities and serious injuries across the state.

"While our existing technology deployed in NSW is already world leading, this agreement will see the introduction of next generation image capture, AI and trailer deployment platforms, amongst other innovation-driven program enhancements.

"The existing program has undoubtedly reduced road trauma and I am really proud to once again be partnering with the NSW government to set a new benchmark in road safety, to save lives, to reduce crashes and injuries."

Transport for NSW took up the option to include seatbelt enforcement services under the previous agreement in 2024 and has proceeded to include both mobile phone use detection and seatbelt non-compliance detection in the scope of the services delivered under the Framework Agreement and the associated project orders.
