Capricorn Copper Insurance Claim Resolution

29Metals Limited ('**29Metals**' or, the '**Company**') today provides an update in relation to the Capricorn Copper insurance claim for loss and damage suffered as result of the Extreme Weather Event at Capricorn Copper in March 2023¹.

Following extensive engagement, Insurers and 29Metals have reached an in-principle agreement to a full and final settlement of the claim for gross proceeds of \$115 million, resulting in a final payment to 29Metals of \$54 million, subject to the finalisation and execution of formal documentation, which is expected to occur during the current quarter. The final payment is in addition to \$61 million in unallocated progress payments paid to date and announced previously².

The full and final settlement includes both the surface and underground components of the claim.

Commenting on today's announcement, Chief Executive Officer, James Palmer, said:

"The proceeds from the full and final settlement of the claim enhances Group liquidity and flexibility as we progress our immediate term strategic objectives. Specifically, the Gossan Valley project at Golden Grove, continuing to progress the imperatives for a future successful and sustainable restart of operations at Capricorn Copper and ongoing exploration programs."
