Cleanaway continues to strengthen VIC Solids with updated MRL agreement

Cleanaway Waste Management Limited (ASX: CWY) today announces it has entered into a Variation Agreement with a subsidiary of Boral Limited, amending the existing Operating Agreement for the Melbourne Regional Landfill (MRL).

Under the Variation Agreement, the parties have agreed to change the planned sequence of future landfilling operations by bringing forward access to an area currently occupied by Boral. In return for a one-off option fee of \$15 million, a new area adjacent to existing MRL operations and currently owned by Boral can be added to the site and governed by the existing Operating Agreement.

Cleanaway has relinquished its contractual rights under the Operating Agreement to landfill the unquarried area located to the north of MRL's current operations.

The agreement also covers various matters to improve our operations at MRL and Boral has ceased litigation relating to the Operating Agreement at MRL.

Cleanaway CEO and Managing Director Mark Schubert said: "The Variation Agreement provides Cleanaway with more efficient airspace with superior approvals prospects by consolidating operations in the southern part of the Deer Park site further away from sensitive receptors.

"This agreement is a key step in future-proofing Cleanaway's Victorian post-collections network, enhancing our ability to meet the long-term needs of our customers and communities. Subject to planning and regulatory approvals, it should extend our operations at MRL beyond 2050, supported by our transfer station network, which in addition to the southeast, now includes coverage of the City and western corridor following the recent acquisition of Citywide's Dynon Road transfer station."
