

TMK OPERATIONS AND TECHNICAL TEAM EXPANDED

TMK has added to its core operations and technical team with three additional appointments including a:

- Full time Operations Superintendent to be based primarily at the Gurvantes XXXV site in Mongolia commencing in November
- Consultant CSG Reservoir Engineer focused on optimising reservoir management and well performance
- Geoscientist advisor with cross-disciplinary skills in CSG exploration, associated subsurface disciplines and project delivery

TMK Energy Limited (ASX: TMK) (**TMK** or the **Company**) is pleased to announce that it has added three key technical and operational members to the TMK team, in preparation for the next phase of development at the Gurvantes XXXV Coal Seam Gas (CSG) Project.

Mongolia-based Operations Superintendent

Mr. Brad Reeve will join the TMK team in November and will be based primarily in Mongolia at the Nariin Sukhait Project site. His experience and skillsets gained from working in the minerals industry in Australia for the likes of Rio Tinto and Gold Fields (amongst others) will be of enormous benefit to TMK as it strives for continuous improvement in its operational capability.

Brad's expertise in managing health and safety, production processes, and general operations, as well as his strong connection to Mongolia through family, made him an ideal candidate for the role. Reservoir Engineer with International CSG expertise

Mr. Garry Ward is a US domiciled reservoir engineer who spends a considerable amount of time in Ulaanbaatar, the capital of Mongolia. Garry has been advising TMK since August this year and has been assisting with the implementation of the revised reservoir management plan (RMP) that the Company has now adopted. Garry has extensive CSG experience in Mongolia, China and the USA and will be instrumental in assisting TMK reach its primary goal at the Pilot Well Project, which is to increase water production and reduce reservoir pressure to ultimately, increase gas flow rates.

Subsurface Leadership

Mr. Greg Channon has almost four decades of multi-discipline subsurface and leadership experience from assignments based in Australian and internationally, including Mongolia and China. Mr. Channon is well known to the Board and management and is assisting TMK in a part time advisory capacity to





provide advice with design and implementation of the upcoming exploration program and provide technical guidance on general geoscience and subsurface matters. Greg will also be assisting in the implementation of the project partnering process which is due to get underway in the coming months.

Mr Dougal Ferguson, TMK Energy's Chief Executive Officer commented:

"It is with great pleasure we welcome Brad, Garry and Greg to the TMK team. Brad's full-time role as Operations Superintendent based at our site in Mongolia is particularly key to our drive for continuous improvement in all our operations, where health and safety and operational efficiency (e.g. keeping the wells running) are critical to the ongoing success of the operations.

Garry and Greg join us having already had prior experience in CSG in Mongolia, and both truly believe in the enormous potential of both CSG in Mongolia and our Project.
