Retraction – Slide 6 of 21 October 2025 Presentation

Alligator Energy (ASX: AGE, 'Alligator' or 'the Company') released an announcement titled "Global Uranium Conference Presentation" on 21 October 2025 ("Announcement").

Slide 6 of the Announcement referred to AGE's Scoping Study Update ("Scoping Study") released to the ASX on 14 December 2023.

In the circumstances, the assumptions underpinning the original Scoping Study have materially changed (for the analyst's current long-term price projections of US\$90 / lb case).

This means AGE cannot rely on Listing Rule 5.19 to streamline the original Scoping Study in the Announcement to update the forecast financial information for the Samphire Uranium Project ("Project").

To present materially different forecast financial information, AGE must comply with Listing Rule 5.16 and 5.17 (which, due to Listing Rule 5.17, requires a discussion of all material assumptions underpinning the production target and the Scoping Study considering the Project's new forecast economics).

AGE has not yet completed a revised Scoping Study which will re-assess all the material assumptions underpinning the Project economics in a form that complies with Listing Rule 5.16 and 5.17.

As the forecast financial information in the Announcement was materially different from the Scoping Study dated 14 December 2023, the Company retracts the updated forecast financial information contained in Slide 6 of the Announcement.

Investors should not rely on Slide 6 of the Company's market announcement dated 21 October 2025, titled "Global Uranium Conference Presentation" in making their investment decisions.
