December 2025 Quarterly Update

Highlights:

- **Ownership Adjusted AUM remained steady at USD29 billion (AUD43 billion)**
 - **Lighthouse's higher fee yielding direct Hedge Funds AUM up 1.7% to USD4.8 billion**
 - **NGI Strategic AUM down 2.5% to USD11.7 billion (up 1.9% excl. Bardin Hill), with Private Markets' AUM up 7.1%**
 - **Continued generation of strong absolute and relative performance during the quarter, benefiting from ongoing market volatility**

Navigator Global Investments (ASX: NGI) ("Navigator", "NGI" or the "Company") provides an update on its assets under management ("AUM") and performance for the three months ending 31 December 2025 (Q2 FY26 or Q2)¹.

Navigator's ownership-adjusted AUM remained steady at USD29.0 billion at the end of the quarter, up 7.0% over the past 12 months. Excluding the impact of the sale of Bardin Hill that closed during Q2, Navigator's ownership adjusted AUM increased by 1.8% in the quarter.

Total NGI Firm Level AUM² decreased by 3.2% to USD83.7 billion during the quarter but grew by 6.6% over the past 12 months. Excluding Bardin Hill, Firm Level AUM increased by 0.3% in Q2.

The backdrop of ongoing geopolitical, interest rate uncertainty and market volatility continues to create an attractive environment for alternative investment managers, with NGI's Partner Firms delivering strong performance on an absolute and relative basis during the quarter. Allocator sentiment toward hedge funds remains positive, alongside a more favourable fundraising outlook for private market managers after a challenging 2025.

Lighthouse Partners ("LHP")

During the last quarter, LHP's AUM increased by 1.8% to a record USD17.3 billion, up 7.5% over the past 12 months.

AUM growth was driven by strong investment performance across LHP's strategies (slide 6 of the attached presentation), with all of the key strategies' 12-month net returns outperforming their three-year and five-year averages.

In particular, LHP's higher fee yielding direct Hedge Funds have performed well amid elevated uncertainty. They are scalable strategies, at or above their performance fee high watermarks, with current market conditions conducive to the continued generation of strong risk-adjusted returns.

NGI Strategic

AUM from NGI Strategic Partner Firms was down 2.5% in Q2, but up 6.4% over the past 12 months.

During the quarter, the sale of Bardin Hill (a US private credit manager with approximately USD3.0 billion in assets under management) to Man Group closed. Excluding the impact of this, ownership adjusted AUM from NGI Strategic Partner Firms increased by 1.9% for Q2.

The strong growth of NGI Strategic Private Markets continued in Q2 with AUM increasing by 7.1%, taking total AUM growth over the past 12 months to 50%, including the impact of NGI partnering with 1315 Capital in March 2025.

NGI continues to see demand from institutional investors and global private wealth management channels for alternative strategies, including select asset classes and strategies offered by NGI's Partner Firms.

Our Partner Firms remain focussed on delivering strong risk-adjusted returns for their respective investors. This continued performance underpins their ability to attract and retain clients, increases base fee revenue from the higher AUM, generates higher performance fee revenue, and creates positive momentum across the business.

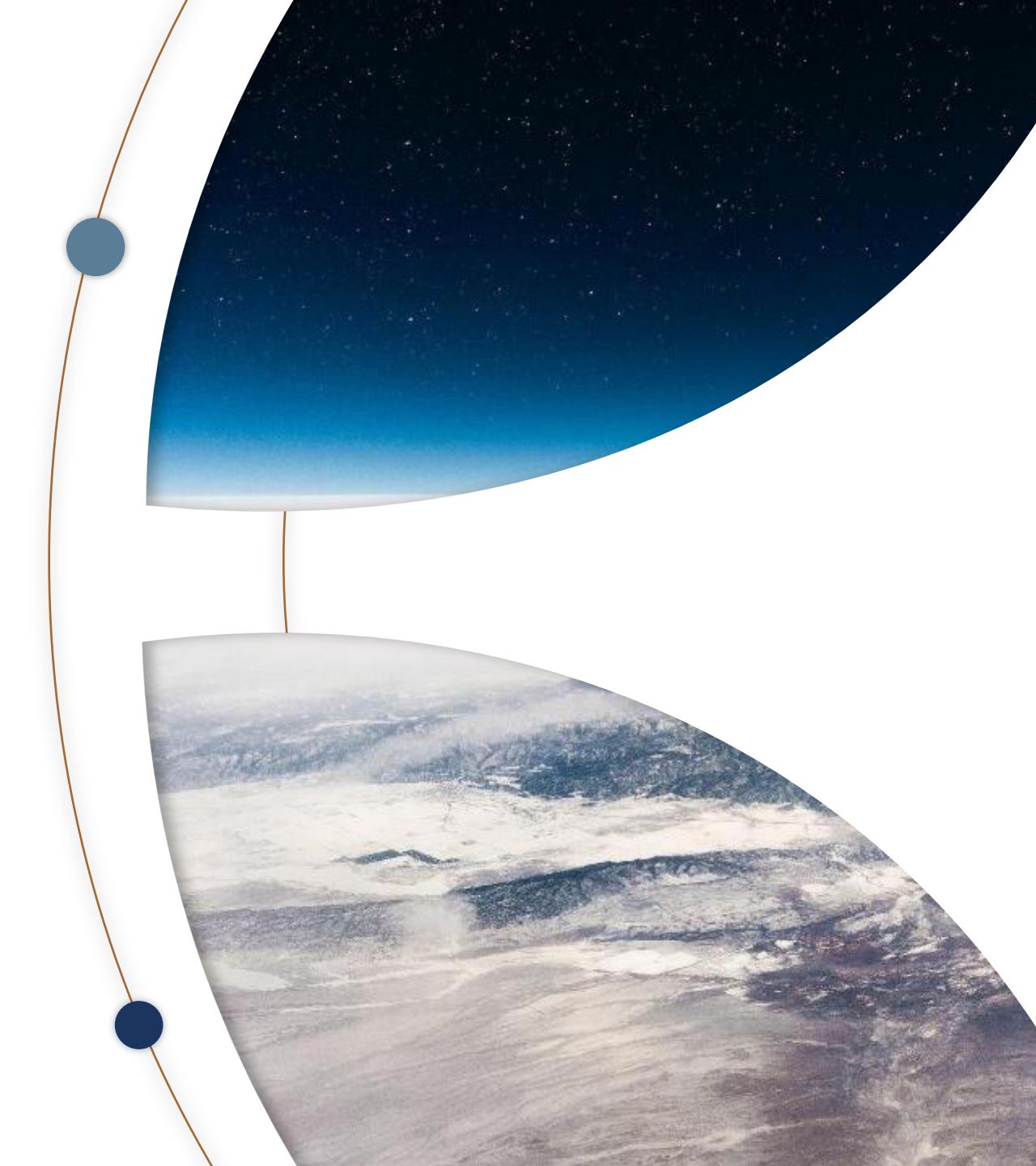

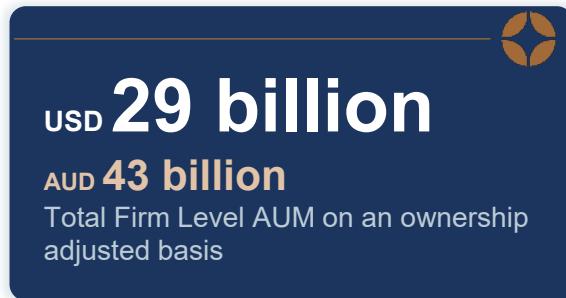

Hedge Fund Research HFRX Equity Hedge Index: This HFRX Equity Hedge Index measures the performance of the hedge fund market. Equity hedge strategies maintain positions both long and short in primarily equity and equity derivative securities. A wide variety of investment processes can be employed to arrive at an investment decision, including both quantitative and fundamental techniques; strategies can be broadly diversified or narrowly focused on specific sectors and can range broadly in terms of levels of net exposure, leverage employed, holding period, concentrations of market capitalizations and valuation ranges of typical portfolios.

MSCI AC World Daily TR Gross USD: A free float-adjusted market capitalization weighted index that is designed to measure the equity market performance of developed and emerging markets. The MSCI ACWI consists of 45 country indices comprising 24 developed and 21 emerging market country indices.

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
